Gentlemen:

Midwest Oil Corporation requests permission to commingle production from the following wells located in the N/2 of Sec. 32, T-13-S, R-34-E:

<u>Lease & Well No.</u>	<u>Field</u>	<u>Prod.</u>	<u>Gravity</u>
State "D" No. 1	Nonombre (Upper Penn)	97 BOPD	40 deg.
State "D" No. 2	Nonombre (Lower Penn)	47 BOPD	40 deg.
State "D" No. 3	Nonombre (Middle Penn)	42 BOPD	40 deg.

The average weighted gravity on all three leases is calculated at 40 deg. API. The base price of oil is \$3.31/bbl. for 40 deg. gravity and above with 2¢/bbl. less for each one degree gravity below 40 degrees. The actual commercial value of such commingled production will not be less than the sum of the values of the production from each common source of supply. Working interest and royalty interest is the same on all leases.

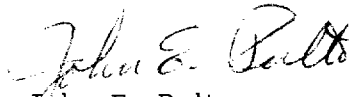

Production will be allocated to wells based on quarterly well tests as shown on schematic diagram. Power oil to the well will be metered. Return oil, including power oil and produced oil, will be metered through a test separator. The difference will be net produced oil. One LACT unit will serve all wells.

The Oil Conservation Commission has requested that upon approval by the State Land Office that they be so notified by them.

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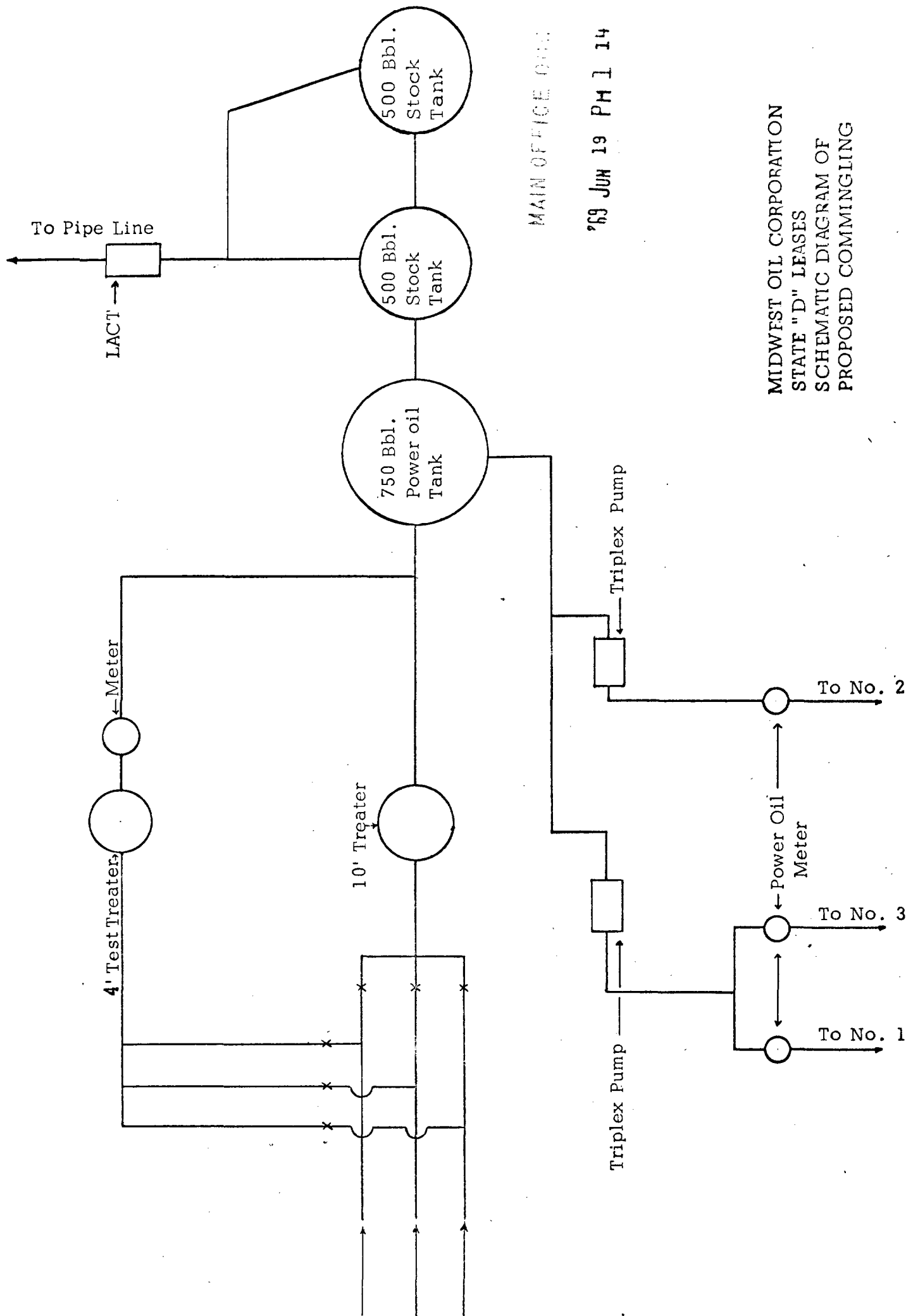
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Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains.
