Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated September 2, 1969, as amended by your letter of October 20, 1969, wherein you request administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Grayburg-San Andres and Drinkard production on your State A-33 Lease comprising the SW/4 NE/4, W/2 SE/4, and SW/4 of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, Hobbs Field, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the Drinkard production and determining the Grayburg-San Andres production by means of the subtraction method. It is our understanding that adequate control valves will be installed to eliminate the possibility of Drinkard production being produced into the system at such time as any San Andres well on the lease is being tested through the test system. Further, that while the test header for the State A-33 production will be located on the State A-33 Lease, the actual commingling will occur at a central tank battery for this lease located in Unit K of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, on your State A-29 Lease.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner. Provided however, that this installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the

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C Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters. Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.

O It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of the aforesaid commingling authority.
