Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application dated November 7, 1969, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Hobbs-Blinebry, Hobbs-Drinkard, and Hobbs-Grayburg-San Andres production from your State "G" Lease comprising the S/2 NW/4 of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each pool.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, Pan American Petroleum Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of the aforesaid commingling authority.

Please notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as this installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made thereof.
