Gentlemen:

This is an application for Administrative authority to permit commingling of oil production from the Hobbs-Blinebry, Hobbs-Drinkard and Hobbs-Grayburg-San Andres pools underlying our State "G" Lease (Land Lease No. A-1573) in the S/2 of NW/4 of Section 33, T-18-S, R-38-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the various pools shall be separately metered and sampled, utilizing temperature compensated meters prior to commingling. The installation and maintenance of the facility shall be in accordance with the "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities."

There will be no appreciable effect of hydrocarbon value due to the equivalence in gravities. See below.

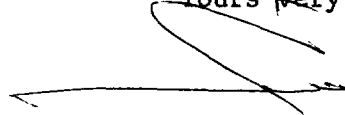

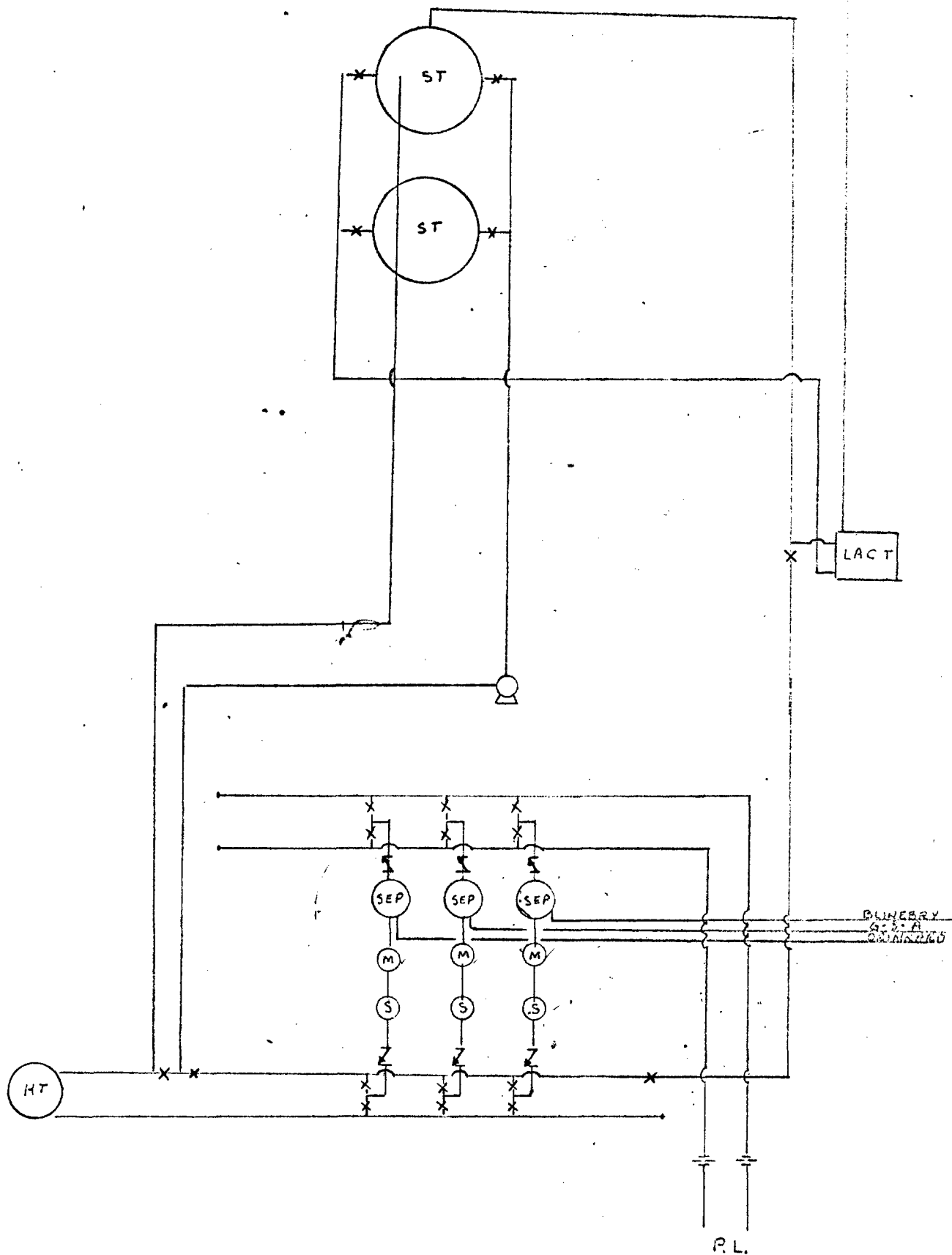

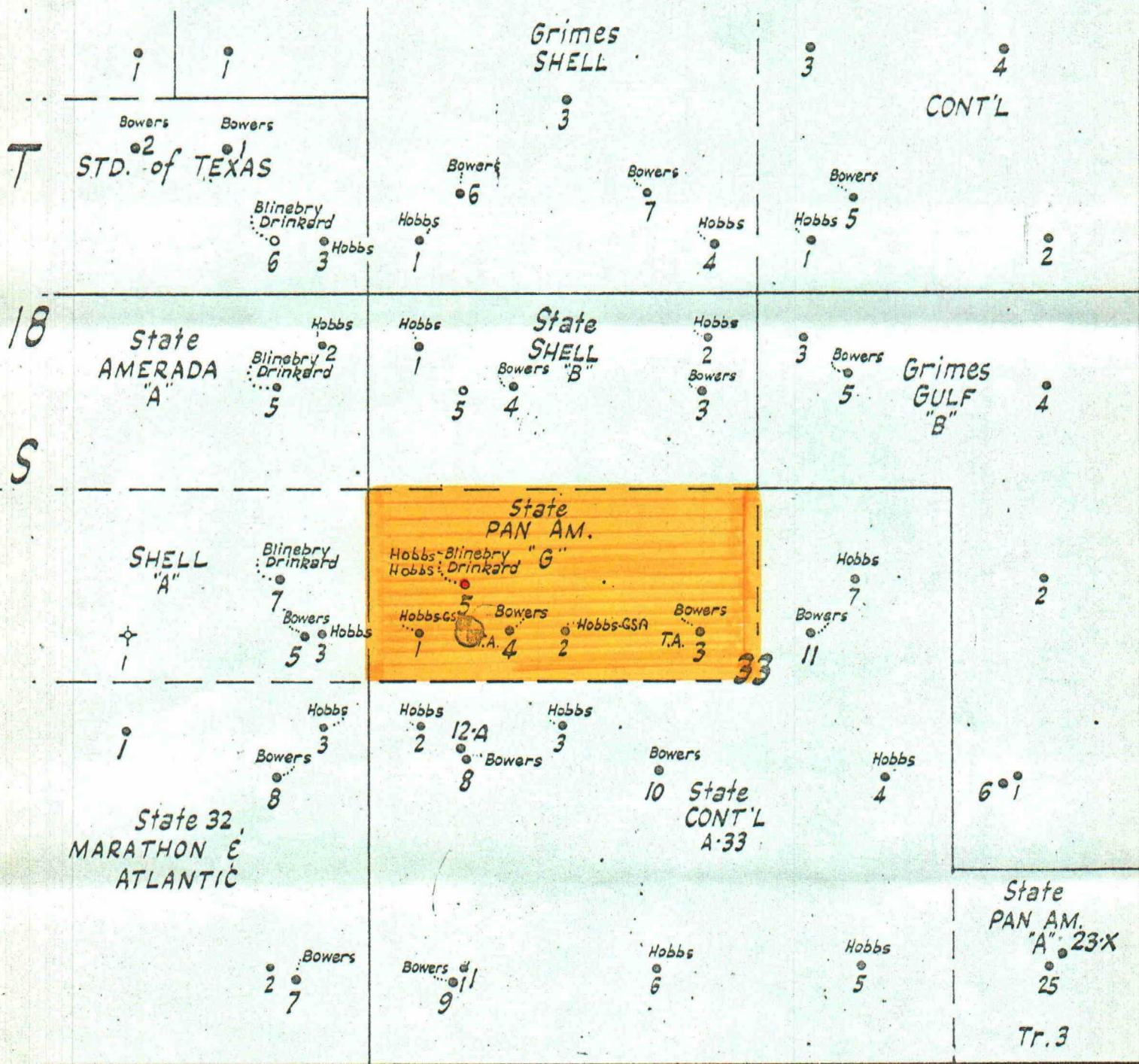
