Gentlemen:

O Reference is made to your application dated December 22, 1970, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Drinkard and Blinebry production on your Gutman Lease comprising the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the production on said lease is of marginal nature and that you therefore propose to allocate the production to each pool on the basis of periodic well tests.

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Y By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well producing into this installation is capable of top allowable production.

It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

Reference is made to your application dated December 22, 1967, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 803-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of oil and gas production in your Gusher lease consisting of the NW 1/4 of Section 11, Township 31 North, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico.
