Dear Sir:

In order to avoid considerable expense in repairing and maintaining the above mentioned tank battery, Gulf hereby seeks Administrative approval to commingle Monument, Monument Blinebry and Monument Paddock production by consolidating the tank battery. The wells producing from all pools are marginal and will be tested periodically for allocation of production.

The attached tabulation shows the volumes, gravities, and monetary values of the liquid hydrocarbons from the individual pools, as well as the commingled production.

The calculated revenue from the commingled production will be slightly more (\$2#/day) than the total revenue from the individual pools.

Attached is a schematic diagram of the proposed installation, along with a lease plat. Also attached is a letter of approval from Shell Oil Corporation and a tabulation of the total average daily production for a 60 day period.

This commingling proposal is in the interest of conservation in that it prevents unnecessary waste and production expense.







