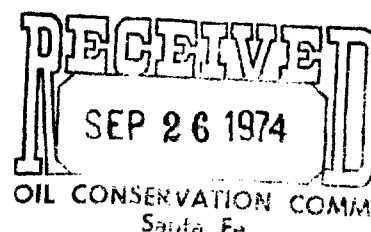

Dear Mr. Porter:

Minerals Management Inc. as agent for Petro Lewis Corporation, Denver, Colorado hereby makes application for exception to Rule 303-A and requests administrative approval to commingle production from the Federal Media Well No. 7 (Undesignated Gallur) and Federal Media Well No. 8 (Undesignated Mesavendo), Sandoval County, New Mexico. The wells are both located on Federal Lease No. ST-04588 ~~844~~. Production will be commingled in a common storage facility.

A plat showing the location of wells on the lease is attached. Other pertinent data is shown on Attachments 2 and 3. A copy of the letter of approval from the U. S. Geological Survey is also attached.

It is proposed that allocation of production be based on annual gas-oil ratio tests. Initial gas-oil ratio tests will be conducted during the first 20 days of commingled production. Gas-oil ratio tests will be conducted on one well at a time with the other one shut-in during the test period.

The commercial value of the commingled production will not be less than the sum of the values of individual production since oil is sold at a flat base price of \$9.71 per barrel.

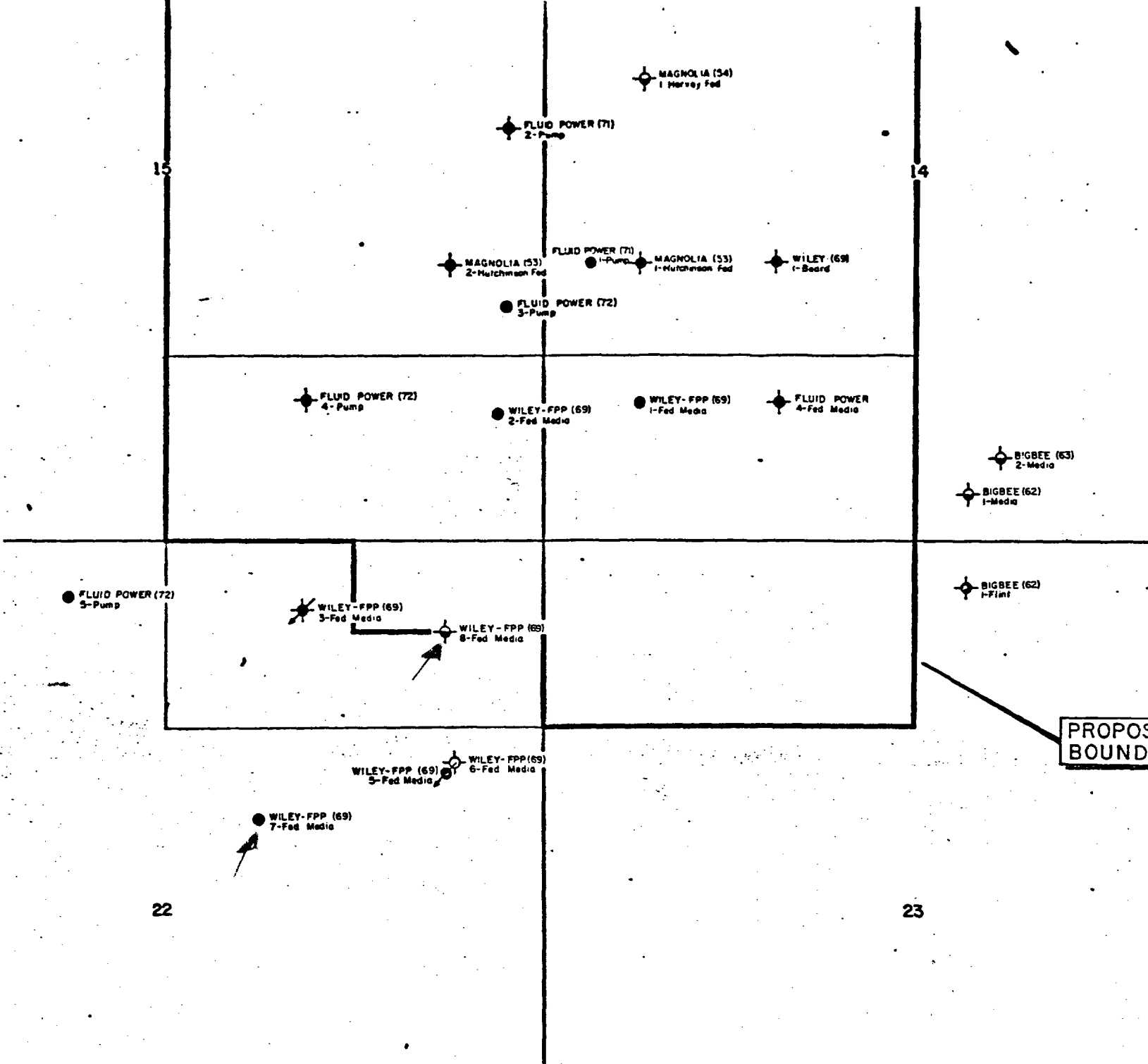

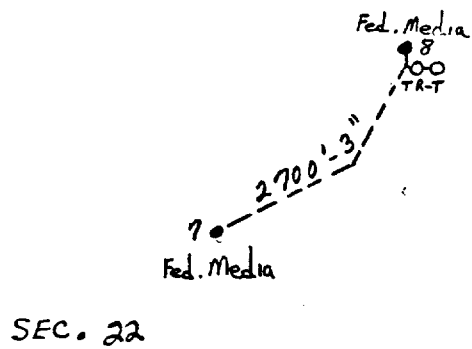

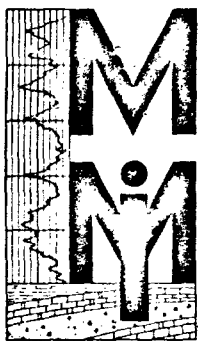
