
In accordance with Commission Rule 303 and the Commission "Manual for
the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," we hereby apply
for permission to commingle the condensate liquids from the subject well
completed in the Blanco Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs gas pool underlying
a commonly-owned lease.

Condensate yields from the Blanco Mesaverde and Pictured Cliffs com-
pletions are expected to be 1.3 barrels per MMcf and 0.34 barrels per
MMcf respectively.

Proration of liquids to their respective producing formation will be based
on semi-annual gas-oil ratio tests. The results will be filed with the Com-
mission on Form C 116.

Attached is a schematic diagram of the commingling installation. We are
simultaneously requesting approval from the Regional Supervisor, United
States Geological Survey.

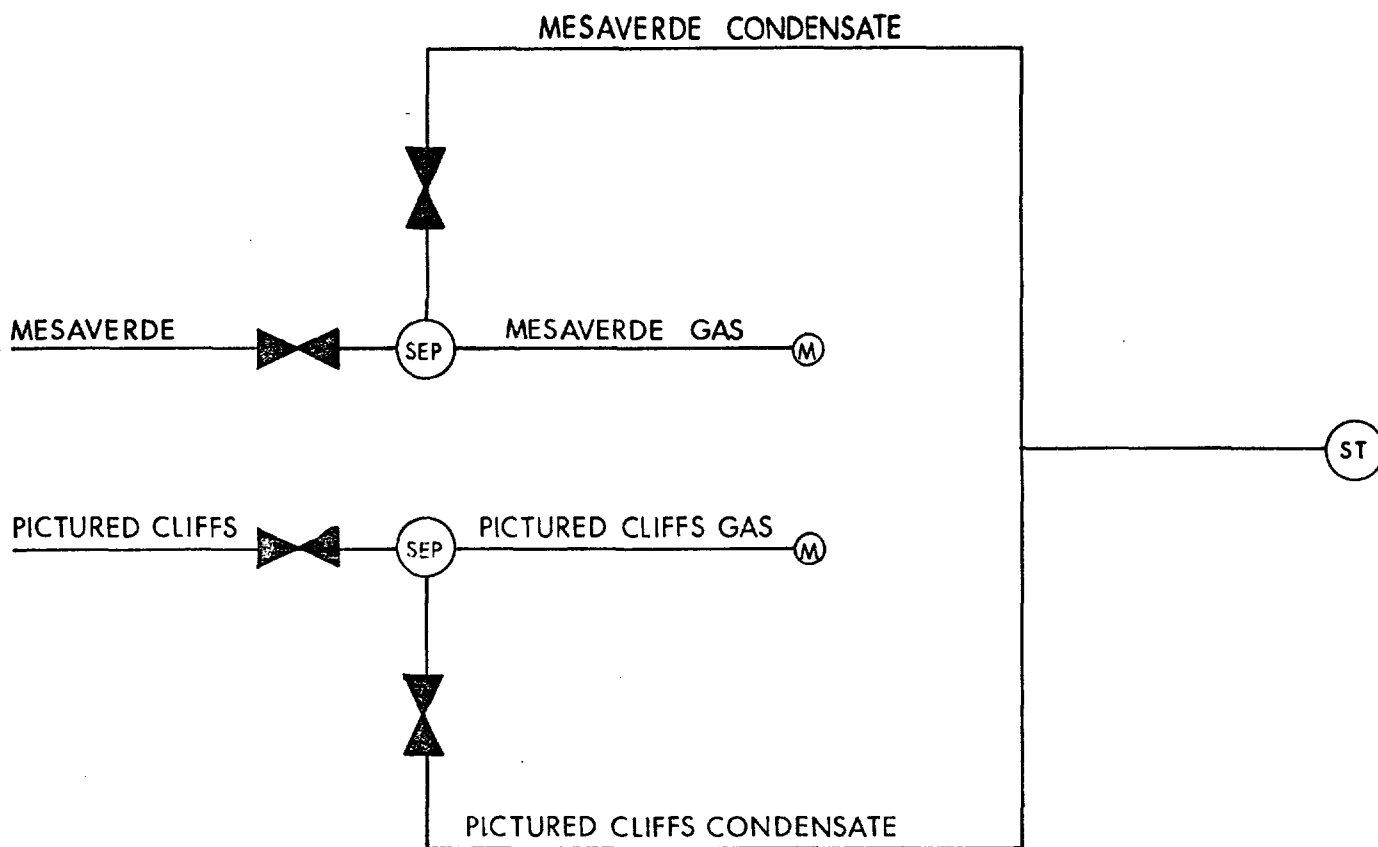
