Proposed Commingling - Elliott A-15 Lease

Continental Oil Company proposes to commingle the Drinkard and Penrose Skelly production from its Elliott A-15 lease. This lease is located in section 15, T-22S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Brunson production from this lease will continue to produce into a separate battery since this production goes into a separate pipeline system.

At the present time the production from the Elliott B-15 lease is produced into separate tanks at the same battery location as the Elliott TA-15 battery. It is proposed to re-vamp this entire battery location to better utilize available equipment, replace worn and unsightly equipment, conserve energy and abide by environmental protection requirements. As a result of this re-vamping we request permission to utilize a common test metering heater-treater. This vessel is to be installed with 3-way, 2-position valves with automatic control hook-up both up-stream and down stream of the vessel. This will prevent any possible mixing of lease/pool production in the test vessel.

Attached is a schematic showing proposed battery installation, plat showing wells to be served by commingled facility and letter from U.S.G.S. approving subject proposal.
