

Dear Sir:

Exxon Corporation is the operator of the New Mexico "AB" State, Well No. 6 recently completed in the Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen Oil Pool, Unit I, Sec. 16, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, N.M.. Exxon Currently has three wells, New Mexico "AB" State No. 2, 3, and 4, producing from the Fowler Upper Yeso Pool.

It is respectfully requested that we be permitted to surface commingle this production and allocation between pools be made on the basis of quarterly well tests. We are advised by the purchaser, The Permian Corporation (Trucks), that they have no objections to this proposal and that the actual commercial value of the commingled production will not be appreciably less than the sum of the values of the production separately.

In support of this proposal, we are attaching the following:

1. Table I showing production, gravity, and classification.
2. A Plat of the current facilities, along with proposed modifications to commingle the Langlie Mattix Seven Rivers Queen and Fowler Upper Yeso Pools.
3. A lease plat showing the location of wells.
