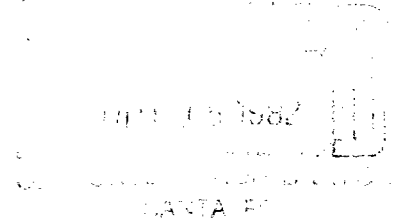

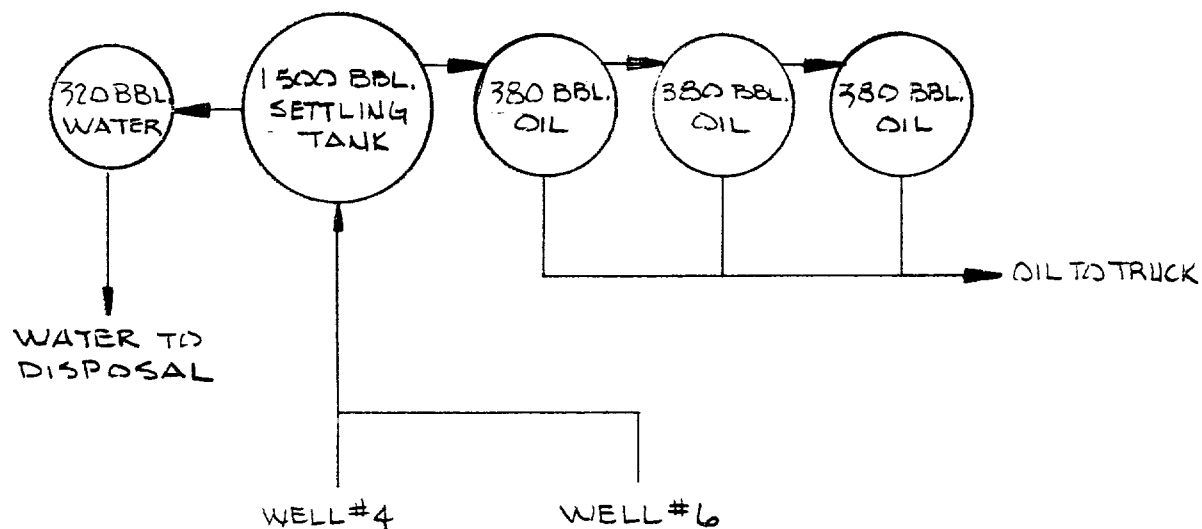

Value/Bbl	\$30.87	\$30.24	\$30.75

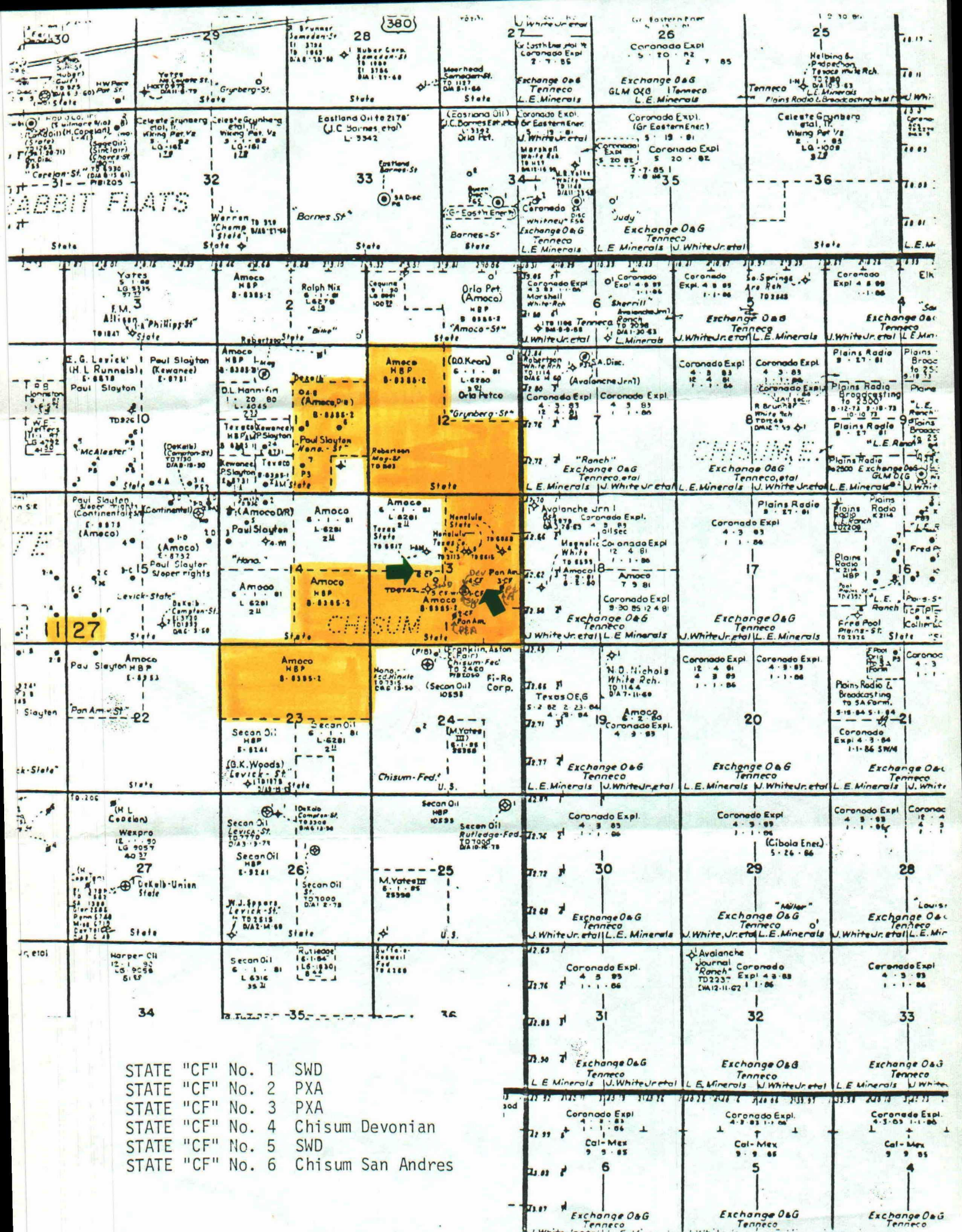
The commercial value of the commingled production will be approximately the same as the total value of the segregated production.

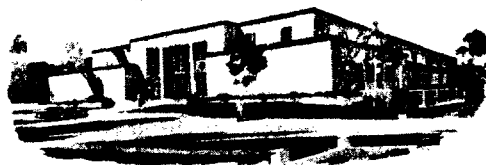
