

APPLICATION

Applicant, J. Felix Hickman, P.O. Box 12307, El Paso, Texas 79912, hereby asks the Oil and Gas Conservation Division for Administrative approval to commingle the oil production only on the below listed well in the subject field.

Schmitz #2-Located 1850' FNL and 790' FWL of Section 16,
T25N, R3W.

1. The Gallup-Dakota as tested is capable of producing 96 bbls. of 45.0 gravity oil/day at \$32.00/bbl.
2. The Mesaverde as tested will produce less than 1 bbl of 59.0 gravity oil/day at \$32.00/bbl.
3. Due to the small quantity of Mesaverde oil, the gravity is expected to average 46.0 after commingled into a storage tank.
4. The commercial value of such commingled oil production should not be less than the sum of the oil production from each zone separated.
5. A schematic diagram of the proposed oil commingle point is attached.
6. A plat showing the location of all wells on the applicants lease is attached.

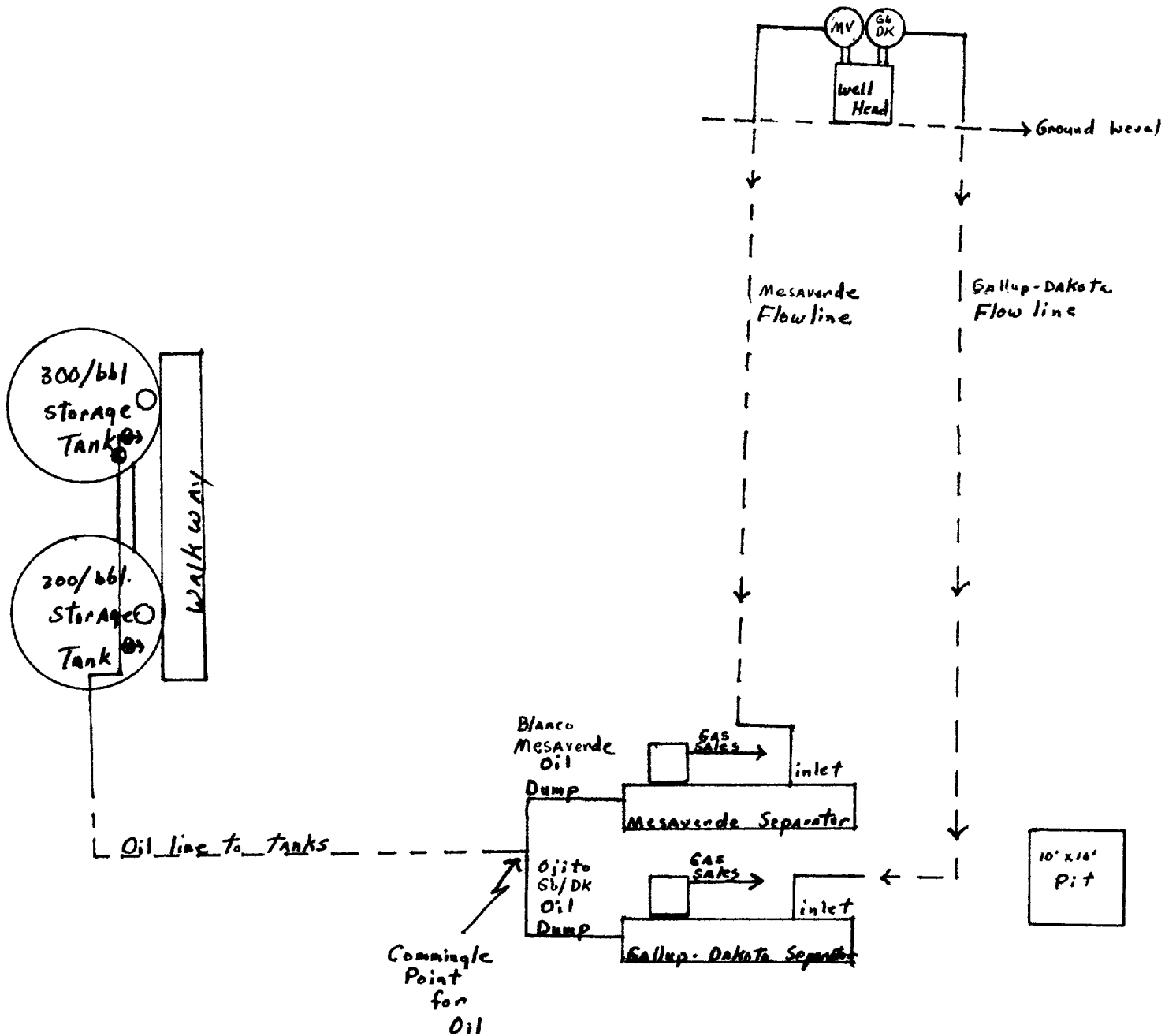
