



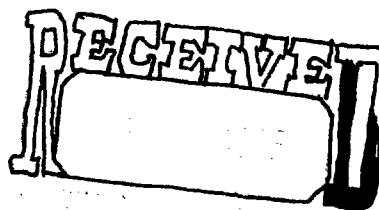

Conoco Inc. requests administrative approval to surface commingle Drinkard production from SEMU Burger B No. 71 with Abo production from SEMU Abo No. 58 and No. 72 at the SEMU Abo battery located in the SE/4 of Section 18, T-20S, R-38E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production data for the above pools is listed below along with the value and gravity.

<u>Zone</u>	<u>Gravity</u>	<u>Daily Volume</u>	<u>Value for Barrel</u>
Drinkard	42.8°	10 BO	\$27.65
Abo	39.7°	110 BO	\$27.65

Production from the Drinkard is considered sweet while Abo production is sour. However, the value is currently the same. Also, as shown, the Abo constitutes the majority of the production; thus, the value of the commingled crude will not be significantly reduced. There are no differing interests involved in the two zones. Production from each zone will be metered separately.

Attached is a battery schematic and lease plat. By copy of this letter, we are notifying the working interest owners and the Bureau of Land Management for their approval of this commingling.

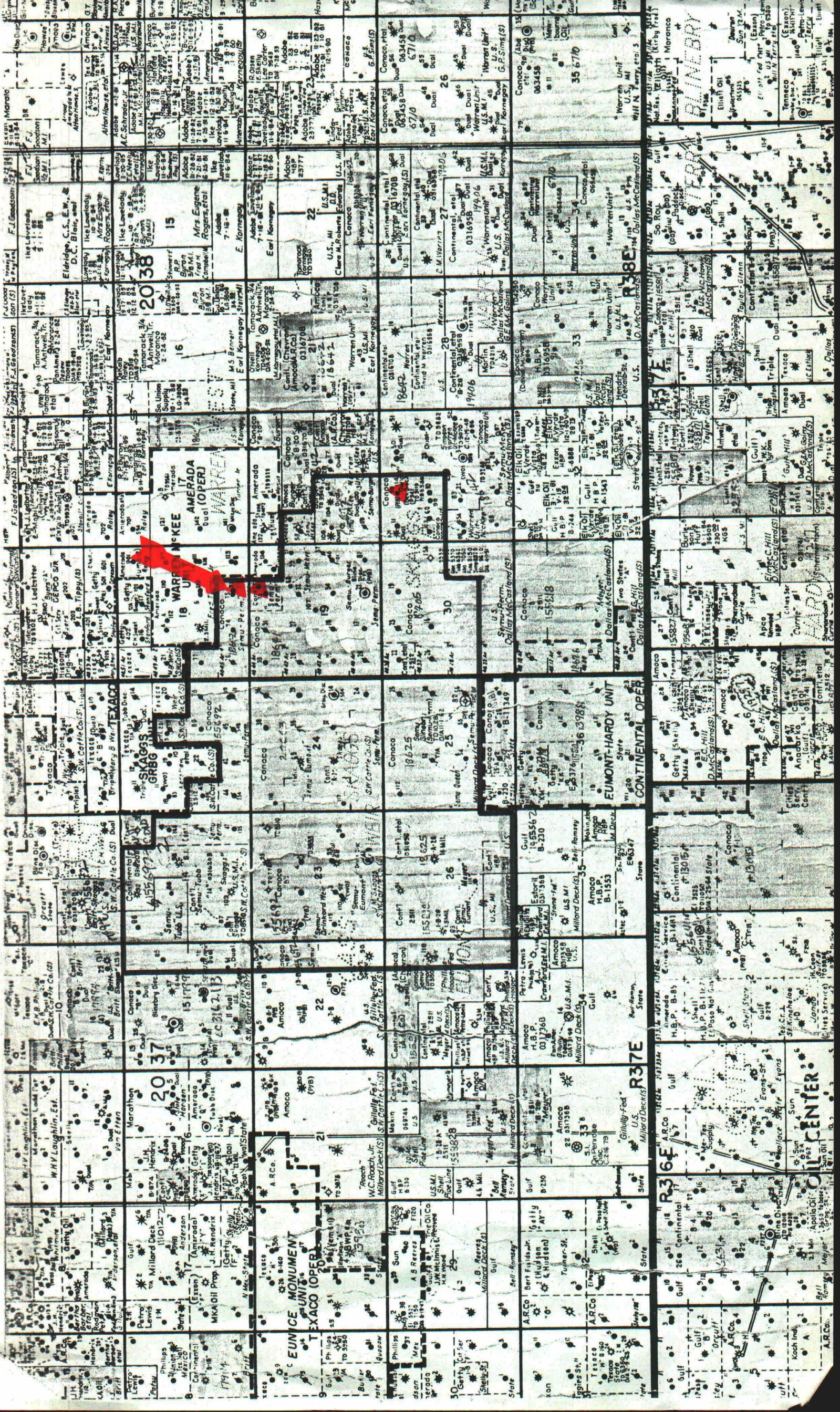
