An exception to NMOCD Rule 303-A is hereby requested for administrative approval to surface commingle oil from the Wingerd Well Nos. 5, 6, 10, 12, 13 (Gladiola Devonian) and Well No. 2 (Southwest Gladiola Mississippian). Ownership of both pools is common. The production from each well will be allocated based on individual well tests. These monthly tests will be facilitated by a recently installed 3-phase separator and the current installation of computer automation. Production data is as follows:

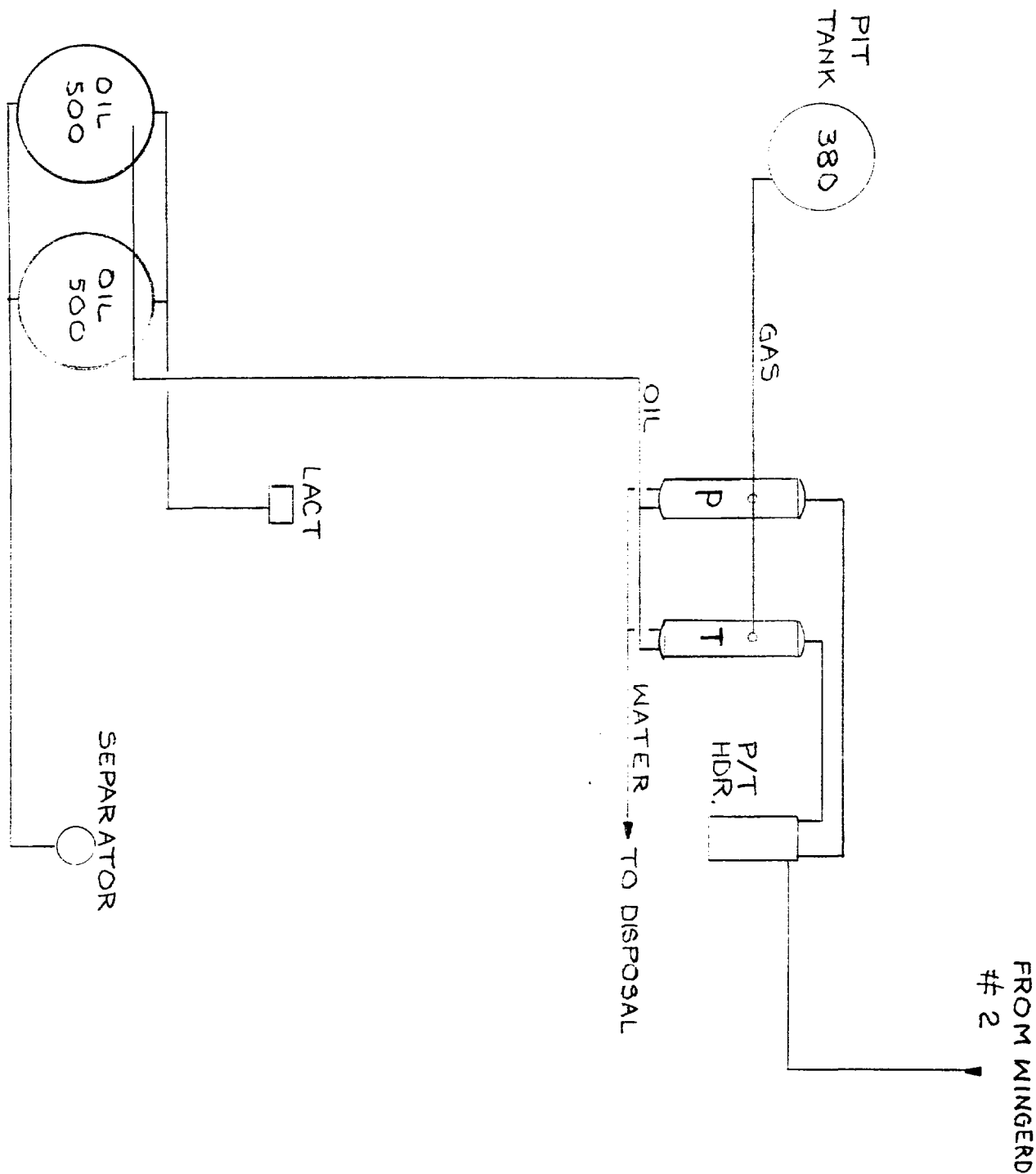
Attached is an ownership map showing the location of each well and a schematic diagram of the installation.
