Re: Surface Commingling Cities' State H Lease, Eunice 7 Rivers Queen, South, Jalmat Tansill Yates 7 Rivers and Langley Strawn Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of your request for approval for an exception to rule 303-A of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Further research on our part has revealed several discrepancies in the information you have sumitted along with the request. Before we can act upon your request, we would appreciate a clarification of those discrepancies.

Your documents indicate three wells to be commingled. you have labelled then the State H numbers 1, 2, and 3. You have them located in the A, H, and G unit letter locations respectively, and indicate they are completed in the Seven Rivers, Yates, and Strawn formations. This information does not agree with production data published by Petroleum Information Corporation, and current as of September 1987.

The following points need to be clarified:

- PI data shows the well in the G location to be operated by Grace Petroleum, not Cities Service;
- PI data shows no well completed in the Strawn in the NE/4 of Section 17, Township 22 South, Range 36 East;
- 3. PI data indicates that the well operated by Cities Service in the A location has not produced since December, 1986. What is its present status?

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In addition, the formula used to calculate the expected gravity of the commingled oils is incorrect, although it does coincidently give the approximated correct answer. API gravities must be converted to specific gravities in order to correctly calculate the combined gravity.

Please provide answers to the above questions, so that we may reach a decision about commingling production from the wells in question. We have attached for your information State Land Office Rule 1.055, entitled Application for Permission to Commingle or Off Lease Store Production.

Your early attention to this matter is appreciated.
