Reference is made to your letter dated October 7, 1991, for an amendment to Division Order No. PC-771 which order authorized the surface commingling of South Corbin-Wolfcamp and South Corbin-Bone Spring Pool production from the Huber "17" Federal Lease comprising the N/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SE/4 of Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that the Huber "17" Federal Well Nos. 2 and 4, previously completed respectively in the South Corbin-Wolfcamp and South Corbin-Bone Spring Pools, have been recompleted to the South Corbin-Delaware Pool. Inasmuch as no pool commingling is currently occurring on the subject lease, no authorization to commingle is required.

As per your request, Division Order No. PC-771 is hereby canceled.
