Reference is made to Administrative Order PLC-9 which on April 2, 1964, authorized the commingling of Vacuum-San Andres and Vacuum-Glorieta production from your State "D" Lease and State "E" Lease after separately metering the production from each pool.

The subject Administrative Order is hereby amended to permit the authorized commingling after continuously metering and sampling the San Andres production and determining the Glorieta production by means of the subtraction method.
