Administrative Order PLC-13

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your recent letter in which you requested amendment to Administrative Order PLC-13 which, as amended, authorizes the commingling of House Abo production from your Howse "C" Lease and House San Andres production from your State "U" Lease, your Cone "A" Lease, your Howse "A" and Howse "B" Leases, and your Cone "B" Lease after separately metering the production from each pool and each lease. It is our understanding that the Abo well on the Howse "C" Lease has been recompleted as a Drinkard well and that you therefore seek the deletion of House Abo and the inclusion of House Drinkard production in the commingling authority.

Administrative Order PLC-13 is hereby amended as described above, with the provision that the installation shall continue to be operated in accordance with the Commission's "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for non-reset counters on the meters.

Dear Sir:

Our Howse "C" Well No. 1, located 1980' FNL x 660' FEL of Section 11, T-20-S, R-38-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico has been recompleted as a marginal producer from the House Abo Oil Pool to the House Drinkard Oil Pool.

This is a request that Administrative Order PLC-13 be amended to provide for the deletion of the HOUSE ABO and the inclusion of the HOUSE DRINKARD Pools' production from the HOWSE "C" WELL NO. 1.

The production will be commingled with other leases producing into the CONE CENTRAL Storage System, located in Unit F, Section 12, T-20-S, R-38-E. A schematic of the facility, together with a plat depicting the leases and wells involved, are attached.

Production from the HOWSE "C" Lease will be separately measured and sampled, and the installation shall be in accordance with the "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." Production from other leases shall be in accordance with previous authority. There will be no reduction in the commercial value of the commingled production since the Abo and Drinkard gravities were of the same.





The purchaser has offered no objection to the proposed substitution.

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


Gentlemen:


