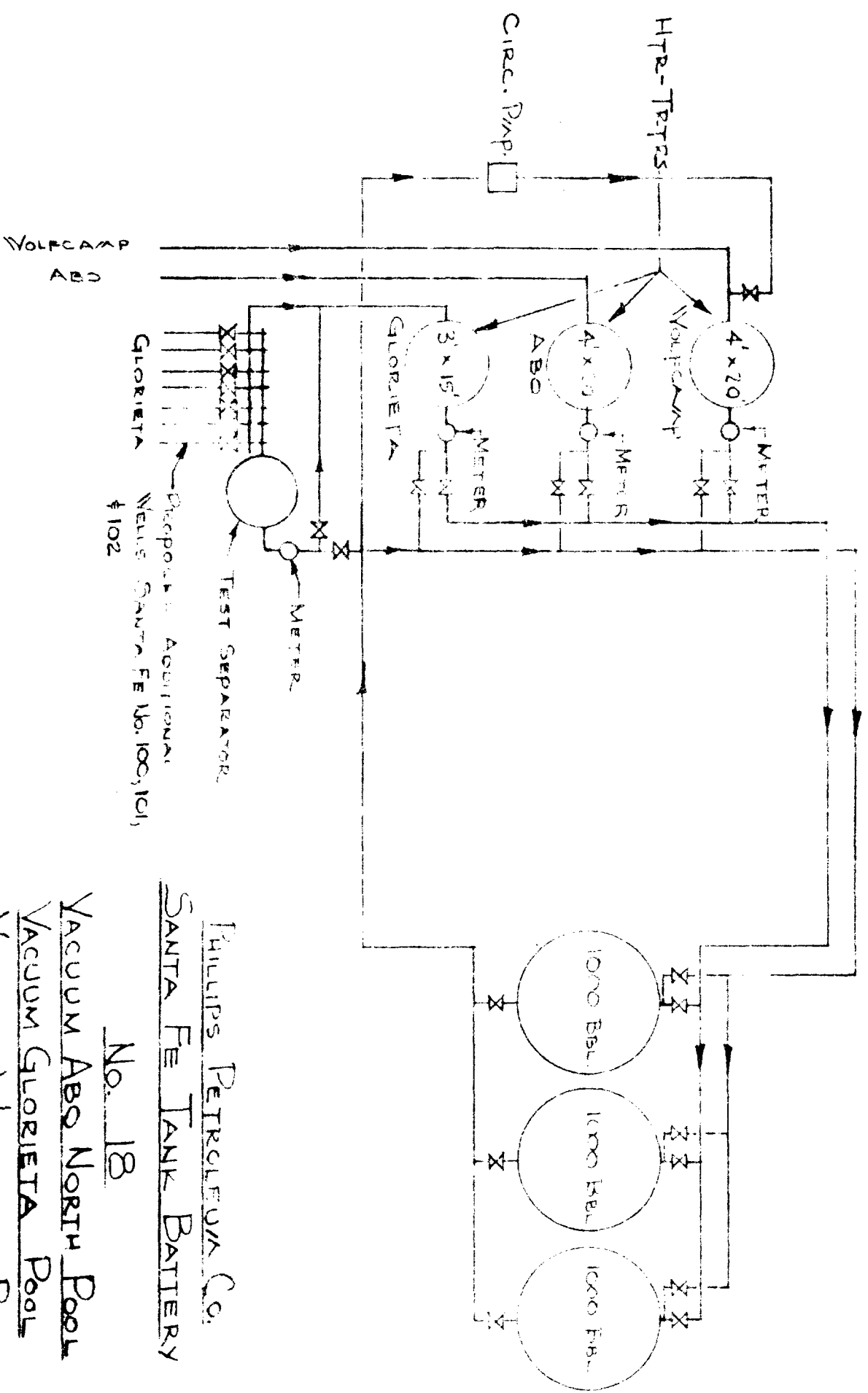

Reference is made to your letter of February 24, 1964, wherein you request that Administrative Order PC-181 be amended to delete the Pennsylvanian zone from the commingling authority contained therein and substituting the Glorieta zone.

Administrative Order PC-181 is hereby amended to provide for commingling of ~~Abo, Glorieta and Wolfcamp~~ production after separately metering the Abo and Glorieta pools and determining the Wolfcamp production by means of the subtraction method.
