O Gentlemen:

P Reference is made to your application for administrative authority to commingle Tubb and Drinkard production on your Belcher Lease comprising the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 7 and Tubb and Blinebry production from your Belcher "A" Lease comprising the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 7, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico, after separately metering the production from each zone and each lease.

Y Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303(b) and Rule 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and leases in the above-described manner. Provided however, that the installation shall be operated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," including the requirement for samplers and non-reset counters on the meters. You are requested to notify the Hobbs District Office of the Commission at such time as the installation is complete in order that an inspection may be made of the installation prior to putting it in operation.

COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN

REPORT

1982-1983

The Commission on the Status of Women was established in 1975 by the United Nations General Assembly. Its mandate is to monitor and promote the implementation of the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW). The Commission's work is carried out through a series of sessions, each with a specific theme. The 1982-1983 session was held in Copenhagen, Denmark, and was the first to be held in a country outside the United Nations Secretariat Building in New York. The Commission's report for this session is divided into several parts, including a summary, a report on the work of the Commission, and a report on the work of the Working Group on Discrimination Against Women and Girls. The report also includes a list of recommendations and a list of countries that have ratified CEDAW. The Commission's work is supported by the United Nations Development Fund (UNDP) and the United Nations Trust Fund for the Status of Women. The Commission's report is a key document in the international human rights system and provides a comprehensive overview of the status of women in various countries around the world.
