Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for an exception to Rule 303-A and Rule 309-A of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Abo, Blinebry, Devonian, Glorieta, Upper-Pennsylvanian, Lower-Pennsylvanian, and Wolfcamp production from your Bridges-State lease and North Vacuum Abo production from your State "J" lease in a common tank battery allocating the production to each well in each pool on the basis of quarterly well tests.

The request is for the State "J" lease comprising the NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 34 East and that portion of the Bridges-State lease comprising the NW/4 NW/4, S/2 NW/4, and SW/4 of Section 24, the N/2 and SE/4 of Section 23, the E/2 of Section 27, and all of Section 26, all in Township 17 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that all leases and pools in this application have common ownership being working interest ownership, royalty ownership, and overriding royalty ownership. Furthermore that all wells in the application are of marginal nature.

Pursuant to the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 303-B and 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations Mobil Oil Corporation is hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools and leases in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation
