The above-named company is hereby authorized to commingle North Vacuum Abo and Vacuum Glorieta pool production from the following leases:

State "A" Lease
NE/4 Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East

State "B" Lease
E/2 SE/4 Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 35 East

State "D" Lease
SW/4 SW/4 Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East

State "E" Lease
SE/4 SW/4 Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 35 East


State "F" Lease
S/2 SW/4 Section 29, Township 17 South, Range 35 East

Production shall be allocated to each lease by well tests (if this method or the subtraction method above is to be authorized, all commingled production must be of identical ownership: working interest, royalty interest, and overriding royalty interest)

This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 309-B of the Commission Rules and Regulations and the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

This order supersedes Administrative Order CTB-224 which authorized the commingling of Glorieta production only from the five subject leases. While not technically eligible for administrative approval, without measurement of production from at least one pool, the Abo production is of such low marginal nature that approval is being given.
