Dear Mr. Prando:

This is in reply to your letter dated February 20, 1992, copy attached.

The referenced wells are producing 4 BO and 15 BO per day respectively. We still need to take both to the State 16 Battery.

An economic analysis of this proposed operation is that we cannot afford to build a complete battery for the current producing rate of less than 20 BO per day from these wells.

Tie-in to the State 16 Battery for both wells will cost \$20,000 for flowlines and labor. To build a complete battery with LACT unit and SWD transfer pump on the lease would cost \$115,000.

At the State 16 Battery we will test each well one time each month through a metered "test" heater treater. This is our company practice for any well less than 50 BO per day.
