

Dear Ms. Corley:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on May 4, 2001; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe and Aztec: all concerning Amoco Production Company's ("Amoco") request for an off-pattern non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for the existing Gallegos Canyon Unit Well No. 93 (API No. 30-045-07699), located 1750 feet from the North line and 890 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 36, Township 29 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool (71629), San Juan County, New Mexico. The W/2 of Section 36 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 320-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
