Dear Mr. Hammond:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated March 7, 2002 (*application reference No. pKRV0-207045058*), which was received by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe on March 8, 2002; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe and Artesia: all concerning Dominion Exploration & Production, Inc. ("Dominion's") request for an unorthodox Morrow wildcat gas well location for the proposed Excalibur 20 Fed Com Well No. 1 to be drilled 1190 feet from the North line and 2180 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 20, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico.

The N/2 of Section 20, being a standard 320-acre lay down deep gas spacing and proration unit for the Morrow formation is to be dedicated to this well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104.F.(2), the above described unorthodox Morrow wildcat gas well location is hereby approved.
