Gentlemen:

This is an application of the Husky Oil Company for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for its Monticeto Woolworth No. 2 located in the Jalpat Gas Field, Lea County, New Mexico. Below is given all pertinent information to this application as set out in your memorandum concerning the filing for non-standard gas proration units.

STATEMENT OF INTENTION:

The Monticeto Woolworth No. 2 well was originally completed in June, 1939, as a Queen San oil producer in the Langlie Mattix Pool. In January, 1945, this zone was plugged off and the Yates gas zone at 3117 to 3196 was perforated and completed for 2,400 M.C.F.G.P.D. on open flow. This well was then assigned an allowable as a Langlie Mattix gas producer. By Commission order on July 6, 1956, this well was reclassified as a Jalpat gas well.



This proposed non-standard gas proration unit is contiguous 80 acres which lies wholly within one section and its entire area is presumed to be productive of gas from the Yates zone. The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280'.

The Husky Oil Company hereby request that the Oil Conservation Commission, in accordance with its order R-520 dated August 12, 1954, grant a non-standard gas proration unit attributable to the Monticeto Woolworth No. 2 which will comprise the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, being a total of 80 acres.




Gentlemen:
