Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST
SE/4 of Section 19

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Quapaw Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the South and East lines and in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPL, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 12 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
