Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Sumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "AK" Well No. 4, located 4215 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line and in Lot 3 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPL, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Sumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 8 of the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
