El Paso Natural Gas Company respectfully requests Administrative Approval under the provisions of Rule 5(b) of Order R-520 for a Non-Standard Gas Provation Unit of 200 acres. more or less, consisting of the SE/4 and SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5. Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. That R. Olsen completed the Wells Federal #1 Well on December 15, 1955. This well was drilled to a total depth of 3575 feet but was plugged back to 3295 feet and is now a well producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool with an initial potential of 21,000 MCF absolute open flow. This well is located 660 feet from the East line, and 1980 feet from the South line of said Section 5.
- 2. That by Bill of Sale dated May 25, 1956, R. Olsen sold this well to El Paso Natural Gas Company.
- That for gas allocation purposes, this well is currently assigned a 160 acre gas proration unit by New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Administrative Order NSP-266 dated May 17, 1956, consisting of the SE/4 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.
