Dear Sir:

J. W. Peery hereby petitions the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for Administrative Approval to dual complete his Leahurst #1 well as a gas well from the Blinney Gas Pool and as a gas well in the Tubb Gas Field. Administrative Approval of an app. producer licensing, and to establish an app. core app-standard gas production unit in said field as provided in Order No. 1, dated April 11, 1950, and to support thereof needed as follows:

- (a) The J. W. Peery Leahurst Lease contains 32 acres. This land is described as follows:  
 W/2 SW/4 of Section 17, T-24-S, R-37-E, S4P, New Country, New Mexico.  
 The attached Exhibit "A" shows the location of this well on J. W. Peery Leahurst Lease together with the location of offset wells. The attached Exhibit "B" shows a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed dual completion.
- (b) Well #1 is located 920' from West Line and 2310' from South Line of Section 17, T-24-S, R-37-E. At present this well is producing from open hole interval 5550'-5930' PWB in the Brinkard Formation of the Brinkard Oil Pool. Well is presently pumping 3 1/2 bbls, and has 2 1/2 bbls water. 3 1/2" casing is set at 6000' and cemented with 300 sacks. Well originally completed July 24, 1951.
- (c) That applicant proposes to dual complete the well in the following manner:
  - (1) Set permanent type bridge plug at 6450' to plug-off Brinkard Formation.
  - (2) Perforate the 3 1/2" casing within the approximate intervals 5550'-5930' in the Blinney Formation in the Blinney Gas Pool and perforate 3 1/2" casing within the approximate intervals 6200'-6350' in the Tubb Formation in the Tubb Gas Field.
  - (3) Set production type packer between these perforations at approximately 6100' to separate the two pay zones.
  - (4) Produce the Tubb Gas through the casing and the Blinney Gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

- (d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Blisbery and gas from the Turkey is in the interest of conservation and protection of cumulative signed.
- (e) That applicants will comply with all Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Commission of oil conservation to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.
- (f) That the manner and extent of proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.
- (g) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion by registered mail.

THHEREFORE, J. H. Peery requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the Turkey well as proposed in this application.

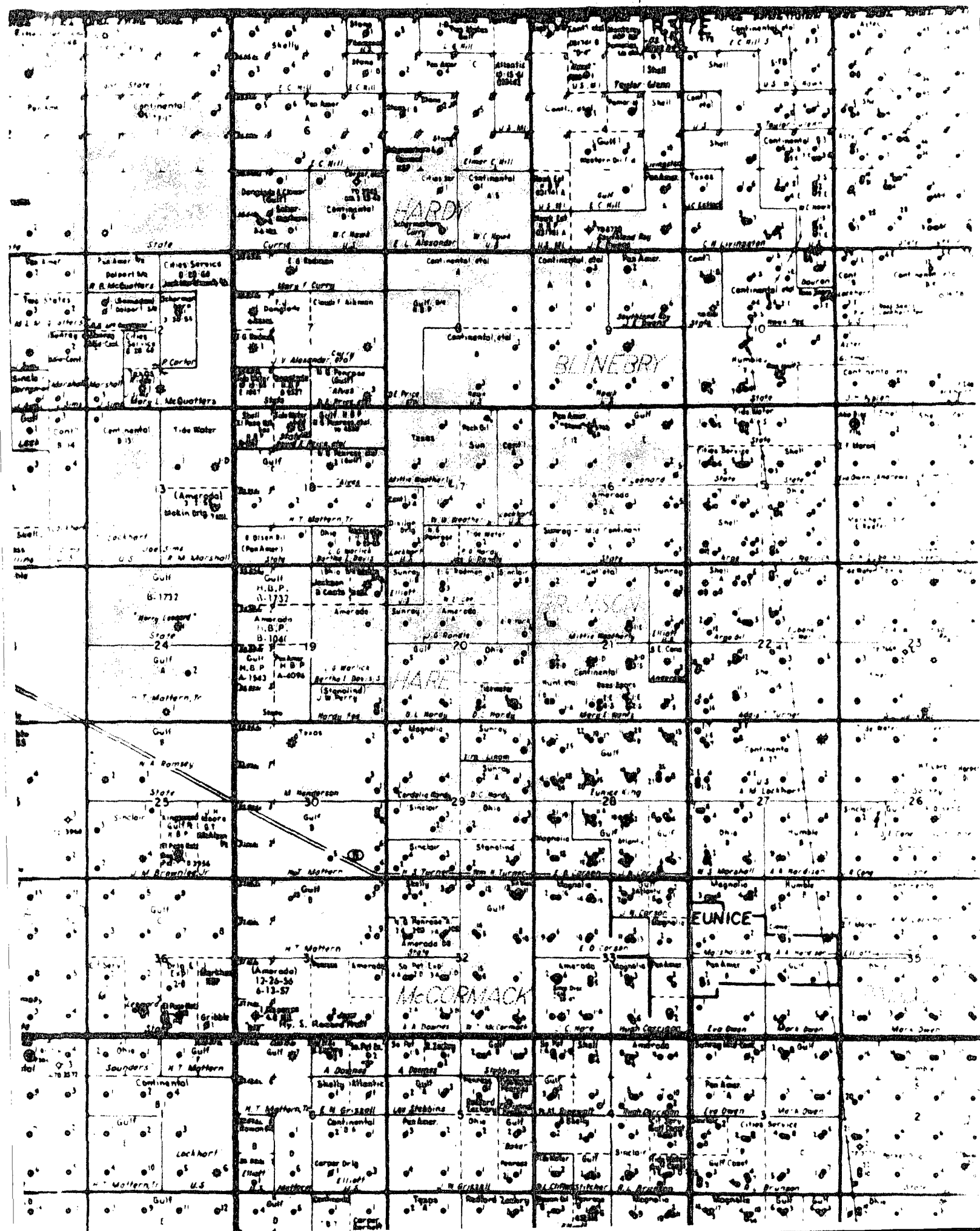
