
Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-520 for the reduction of the presently approved 160 acre unit to a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 34, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, for its Stevens A-34 No. 1 well located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 34, Township 23 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said proposed non standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished this date by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well, as required by the provisions of said Rule 5 (b).

A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief the proposed unit, the location of the No. 1 well and other wells on the lease, offset wells and ownership thereof.
