Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM, Lea County, N. M.
Section 34: NE/4, N/2 NW/4 and the SE/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Stevens A-34 Well No. 2, located 1650 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 34.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 280 acres.
