Under the provisions of Commission Order No. R-520, Rule 5 (b) Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, delegating the Secretary of the Commission authority to grant exceptions to the requirement of Rule No. 5 (a) without notice and hearing for a non-standard gas proration unit, Pan American Petroleum Corporation hereby applies for an exception to the aforementioned rule for L. 5. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit of 40
contiguous acres consists of the SE/4 of SW/4 of Section

7. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

9. The entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies within the horizontal limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool.
