Gentlemen:

Please refer to our request of May 28th, for a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the NW/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico and to your reply dated June 2nd.

Please be advised that the unit well for this acreage will be the B.M. Justis #7, located 1960' FNL and 1980' FWL of the section. This well is a dual completion in the Jalmat Gas Pool and the Jalmat Oil Pool, completed as a dual by the authority of Administrative Order of the Oil Conservation Commission No. DC -714, dated December 30, 1958.

The NW/4 of Section 20, Township 25 South, Range 30 East, Lea County, New Mexico is at the present time dedicated to the V.H. Justis #1, located 990' FNL and 330' FWL of the section. Since the completion of the B.M. Justis #7 well, we request that the B.M. Justis #7 be the unit well and that the V.H. Justis #1 well be shut-in.
