Application is made herewith for a 40-acre non-standard proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool for J. R. Cone Anderson Well No. 1. The non-standard unit will comprise all of the J. R. Cone Anderson lease, being all of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (Unit I) of Section 21, T-21-S, R-37-E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The location of Anderson Well No. 1 and the acreage to be dedicated thereto are shown on the attached Form C-128 "Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat".

For your information, J. R. Cone Anderson Well No. 1 is a dual completion in the Drinkard Oil and Tubb Gas Pools. Dual completion of the well was effected in November, 1951 under New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-83.

Each offset operator in the Tubb Gas Pool to the J. R. 


