Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Federal "F" Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 29.
