Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, LEAD
Section 8: S/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Cliff Well No. 5, located 660 feet from the West line and 1920 feet from the South line of said Section 8.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
