Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 240-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Burnet Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPH
Section 1: S/2 N/2 and N/2 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Leckhart B-1 Well No. 4, located 1920 feet from the North line and 2310 feet from the East line of said Section 1.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Burnet Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 240 acres.
