Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPN
Section 1: 6/2 SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Lockhart D-1 Well No. 6, located 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 1.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 80 acres.
