Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinbry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 16: NE/4 NW/4 and S/2 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your State "C" Tract 12 Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the North line and 3300 feet from the East line of said Section 16.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinbry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
