Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. hereby requests reinstatement of Adminis-  
trative Order NSP-589, dated February 26, 1962, which was approval  
of an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry  
(Gas) Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Lea County, New Mexico  
Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM  
Section 29: S/2 SW/4

This order was issued when it appeared from tests that  
the gas-oil ratio of the Blinebry Oil Pool in the A. H. Blinebry  
(NCT-2) Well No. 5, had increased to 66,417 cubic feet per  
barrel which was in excess of the 32,000 gas-oil ratio limit for  
the Blinebry Oil Pool. However, a multi-point back pressure  
test indicated a ratio of 28,434 cubic feet per barrel. As a  
result of the multi-point back pressure test and the request of  
TEXACO Inc., Administrative Order NSP-589 was cancelled by New  
Mexico Oil Conservation Commission letter dated July 2, 1962.

The request for reinstatement of this order is based  
upon the following gas-oil ratio test data:






