Gentlemen:

In compliance with Rule 30, Order No. R-1670, which prohibits the simultaneous dedication of acreage to an oil and to a gas well, Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests Administrative approval of a Non-Standard 120-Acre Blinebry Gas Proration Unit covering the N/2 SW/4 and SW/4 SW/4 of Section 20, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Gulf's C. L. Hardy Well No. 5, located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 20-21S-37E, is completed in the Blinebry Gas Pool and is assigned a standard 160-acre proration unit covering the SW/4 of Section 20.
- (2) Gulf's C. L. Hardy Well No. 2, located 554 feet from the south line and 2086 feet from the west line of this Section 20 has been dually completed in the Blinebry and Paddock Oil Pools.
- (3) The proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit consists of quarter-quarter Sections and lies wholly within a single governmental quarter Section.
- (4) The entire Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 2,640 feet.



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- (6) All operators within 1,500 feet of the unit well have been furnished a copy of this application. Gulf owns all the leasehold interest in the quarter Section in which the proposed Non-Standard Unit is located.
