Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 230-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 18: SW/4 and S/2 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Lockhart "A" Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the west line of said Section 18.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 230 acres.
