Gentleman:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 6: NE/4 NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your U.S.A. H. V. Pike Well No. 1, located 330 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of said Section 6.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the special Rules and Regulations for the Tubb Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.
