Re: Application of Gulf Oil Corporation for Approval of a Non-Standard
80-Acre Gas Proration Unit, Blinebry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

In compliance with Rule 30 Order No. R-1670, which prohibits the simultaneous dedication of acreage to an oil and to a gas well, Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard 80-acre Blinebry gas proration unit covering the E/2 NE/4 of Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This non-standard unit is to be attributed to the Vivian Well No. 4. In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Applicant's Vivian Well No. 4 located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 30 is completed in the Blinebry Gas Pool and is assigned a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit covering the N/2 NE/4 and SE/4 NE/4.
- (2) Applicant's Vivian Well No. 6 located 1980 feet from the east line and 660 feet from the north line of this Section 30 is being completed as a Blinebry oil well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections within a single governmental quarter section.
- (4) The entire non-standard gas proration unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 2640 feet.
- (6) All Operators in the quarter section in which the proposed non-standard unit is located and within 1500 feet of the unit well have been furnished a copy of this application.
