Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM  
Section 13: NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your R. M. Marshall Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 13.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Eumont Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres.

This approval will not be effective until your R. M. Marshall Well No. 1-B, located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 13, has been disconnected from the pipeline and a Disconnection Notice has been filed with the District Supervisor, District No. 1, Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, New Mexico.
