Administrative Order NSP-629

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 21: SW/4 SE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Wantz Well No. 8, located in Unit 0 of said Section 21.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Blinebry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.

The 120-acre non-standard proration unit approved by Order No. NSP-487 shall be reduced to an 80-acre non-standard proration unit effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to the first oil well completed on the 120-acre tract. The 40-acre non-standard proration unit approved by this order shall be effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to the second oil well completed on the 120-acre tract.
