This is Shell Oil Company's application for a 40-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit to be dedicated to Shell Argo No. 3, Blinebry (Gas) Field, Lea County, New Mexico. As shown on the attached plat, this well is located 1980 feet from south line and 1980 feet from west line of Section 15, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Shell Argo No. 3 was completed as a Blinebry (Gas) producer in October 1952. Currently, 160 acres (outlined in red on the attached plat) are dedicated to this well.
