Gantlemen:

Cur State "S" Blinebry Gas Proration Unit currently consists of the 160 acres in units A, B, C, and D of Section 15, Township 21-S, Range 37-E. We recently requested administrative approval to dual our State "S" Well No. 3 (Unit B, Sec. 15, T-21-S, R-37-E) in the Blinebry and Drinkard oil zones. We now request that the 80 acres in Units A and B of Sec 15, T-21-S, R-37-E, be released from their commitments to the 160 acre State "S" Blinebry Gas Proration Unit so that the released acreage may be developed in the Blinebry Oil Zone.

The release of this acreage will leave only the 80 acres in Units C and D of Sec. 15, T-21-S, R-37E to be dedicated to the Blinebry Gas Proration Unit. We therefore request that the 80 acres in Units C and D of Sec. 15, T-21S, R-37E, be approved as a Non-standard Gas Proration Unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool

The proposed 80 acre unit will consist of centiguous acreage as shown on the attached plat. State "S" Well No. 2, which lies in Unit C, is the producing well of the proposed unit.

We assume that the 80 acres of the proposed unit will be considered productive by the Commission, since this same acreage was considered productive in the previous 160 acre gas unit.
