Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 27: S/2 NW/4 and NW/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Lockhart A-27 Well No. 8, located 810 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 27.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Blinebry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.

This order shall be effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to your Lockhart A-27 Well No. 1, located in Unit C of said Section 27.
